

District Governors' Honorary Committee Duties & Responsibilities

The District Governor may appoint a District Governor's Honorary Committee composed of Past International Officers who are members in good standing of Clubs within the District. This Committee shall meet when and as called upon by the District Governor. It shall act under the direction of the District Governor in the promotion of harmony throughout the District; perform duties as directed by the District Governor; take problems assigned by the District Governor and recommend solutions to him/ her after careful study; and nominate the OSEAL forum Chairman for endorsement by the Multiple District Convention at the appropriate time when it is the turn of the District. The Chairperson of this Committee shall attend meetings of the Cabinet when requested by the District Governor.

District Chairperson - Lion Protocol Duties & Responsibilities

- Act as a resource person to give advices to clubs in regards to official protocol policy of the District.
- Prepare, review and update District Order of Precedence.
- Be familiar with the District, Multiple District and Lions Clubs International Official Protocol Policy.
- Ensure the Official Protocol Policy of the District is followed at all Lions functions and events.
- Possess a good knowledge on the local protocol and custom for non-Lion dignitaries.
- Observe the Head Table and Multi-Head Tables seating and introductions during official events.
