





DISTRICT GOVERNOR

A Leader who inspires and leads to make a difference.

A Leader who believes that by creating an organization focused on serving those in need, he/she could improve the lives of many.

A Leader who has the courage to carry through on his/her idea, the commitment to put forth the necessary effort, and take action to turn his/her dream into a reality.



AS YOUR JOURNEY BEGINS

Serving as District Governor is the honor of a lifetime. To be District Governor, you must meet the following Requirements:

An active member in good standing of a chartered Lions Club in Good Standing in his/her Single or Sub-District.

 Endorsed by his/her Lions Club or a majority of the Lions Clubs in the District.

 Currently serving as the First Vice District Governor within this District.

 Had served as Second Vice District Governor within this District.

NOTE: Candidate who runs for the office of Second Vice District Governor must fulfill the following qualifications:

- Club President: Year Served
- Club Board of Directors
 Two (2) Years Served
- District Cabinet (check one)
 Zone or Region Chairperson Year Served
 Cabinet Secretary and/or Treasurer) Year Served
- One (1) additional year as a member of District Cabinet Position held: ______Year Served_____
- ☐ With none of the above being accomplished concurrently.





DISTRICT GOVERNOR'S ROLES AND REPONSIBILTES

Under the general supervision of the International Board of Directors, he/she shall represent the Association in his/her District. In addition, he/she shall be the Chief Administrative Officer in his/her District and shall have direct supervision over the First and Second Vice District Governor, Region Chairpersons, Zone Chairpersons, Cabinet Secretary, Cabinat Treasurer and such other Cabinet Members as may be provided for in the District Constitution and By-laws. His/her specific roles and responsibilities shall be to:

(a) Serve as the Global Action Team District Chairperson to administer and promote Membership Growth, New Club Development, Leadership Development and Humanitarian Service to Clubs throughout the District.

(1) Ensure the selection of a qualified Lion leader for the positions of GST District Coordinator, GMT District Coordinator and GLT District Coordinator.

(2) Ensure Regular Meetings to discuss and advance initiatives established by the District Global Action Team.

(3) Collaborate with the Multiple District's Global Action Team

(b) Promote the Lions Clubs International Foundation and all Service Activities of the Association.

(c) Preside, when present, over Cabinet, Convention and other District Meetings. During any period he/she is unable to so preside, the Presiding Officer at any such meeting shall be the First or Second Vice District Governor, but if he/she is not available, the District Officer chosen by the attending Members shall preside.

(d) Promote harmony among the chartered Lions Clubs.

(e) Exercise such supervision and authority over Cabinet Officers and District Committee Appointees as is provided in this District Constitution.

(f) Ensure that each Lions Club in the District be visited by District Governor or other District Officer once every year to facilitate successful administration of the Club, and that the visiting Officer submit a visitation report to the International Headquarters for each visit.

(g) Submit a current itemized statement of total District receipts and expenditures to his/her District Convention or Annual Meeting of his/her District at a Multiple District Convention.

(h) Deliver, in a timely manner, at the conclusion of his/her term in office, the general and/or financial accounts, funds and records of the District to his/her successor in office.

Report to Lions Clubs International all known violations of the use of the Association's name and emblem.

(j) Perform such other functions and acts as shall be required of him/her by the International Board of Directors through the District Governor's Manual and other directives.







LCI & DISTRICT – CURRENT EXPENSE REIMBURSEMENT POLICY

The District Governor will be provided a budget annually to subsidize the costs for annual Club visits, new Club organization and meetings for the purpose of District and Multiple District administration.

LCI :

a. Automobile

The allowance for automobile is US\$0.50 per mile (US\$0.31 per kilometre), all inclusive. If a car rental is used, reimbursement would be the US\$0.50 per mile or US\$0.31 per kilometre, all inclusive.

b. Railroad

If rail travel is used, first class and Pullman (roomette) fare will be reimbursed, provided that cancelled tickets are attached to the claim.

c. Transportation by Air

Tickets must be economy round-trip airline ticket by the shortest and most direct route. Airfares will be reimbursed based on actual costs, including service charges, booking fees and credit card fees.

Fees for one bag will be reimbursed within the airline's guideline

for size and weight with paid receipt. Reimbursement must be accompanied by proof of payment / Cancelled airline tickets or detailed E-ticket/itinerary.

d. Other travel related expenses

Taxi fare, ride share services such as Uber and Lyft, shuttle buses, tolls, ferry, parking and other travel related expenses will be reimbursed with proof of payment.

e. Lodging

Reimbursement will be made (with proof of payment) for actual costs only, not to exceed US\$75.00 per night.

f. Meals

Reimbursement will be made for actual costs only, not to exceed US\$25.00 per meal up to a maximum of three meals per day (original itemized receipts must be attached). No charges for alcoholic beverages will be reimbursed.

DISTRICT

Expenses of the District Governor in connection with his/her attending District or Club functions not reimbursable from LCI shall be considered as District administrative expense. Reimbursement for such expenses shall be made on the same basis as outlined in the Rules of Audit of LCI.

Eligible Expenses

REIMBURSABLE EVENTS

a. CLUB VISITATION

b. MEETINGS TO SUPPORT DISTRICT ADMINISTRATION

District Meetings – Up to six meetings which may include Club Officer orientation (held within 60 days prior to or after June 30th), Cabinet Meetings, the District Convention and/or District Membership and/or Leadership Development Meetings. These in-person Meetings should not exceed two days and two nights each.

Multiple District Meetings – Up to three Multiple District functions which may include Council Meeting, Multiple District Conferences, Multiple District Conventions, or Multiple District Global Action Team GMT, GLT, GST and Club Quality Program Meetings. These in-person meetings should not exceed three days and three nights each.

b. HOSTING AN INTERNATIONAL PRESIDENT OR VICE PRESIDENT

The District Governor may submit his/her expenses for an additional Club visit or District Meeting for which an International President or Vice President is attending for either in-person or virtual attendance.

CLUB VISITATION

To successfully manage the District, the District Governor is expected to personally contact each Club President during his/ her term in office. It is also encouraged that each Club be visited either inperson or virtually by the District Governor, First Vice District Governor or Second Vice District Governor once every year to facilitate successful administration of the Club.

The District Governor or approved First Vice District Governor or Second Vice District Governor will be reimbursed for the expenses related to Official Visits to Club in the District.

The purposes of a Club Visitation are to:

(1) Promote Membership Growth, Leadership Development and Service Activities within the Club.

(2) Explore, together with Club Members, the future Membership and Leadership Growth plans.

(3) Discuss challenges and possible opportunities for improvement.

(4) Encourage Clubs to function within the Rules and Policies of LCI and conduct meaningful Humanitarian Service. Convey the messages from the International President, the Board of Directors, and the District.

(6) Encourage and assist with the reinstatement of Clubs that are in financial suspension, status quo or have been cancelled within the previous 12 months.

Organizational Visits – expenses will also be reimbursed for in-person or virtual visits to Clubs in the process of organization, but not yet chartered.
