Message from 58th & 59th MD308 Lions Convention Organizing Chairperson



Since March 2017, the Lions Clubs from District 308-A2 Region 2 & 3 have started on the organizing and preparation of the bidding, for the 2020 Convention and submitted our bidding documents in 2018, and obtained the Council Awarded Letter to approve us to Host the 58th MD308 Lions convention. Ever since then, the whole Organizing Committee has been working very hard in the preparation and the organizing works. In March 2020, the Organizing Committee was excited and uneasy to finalize the final leg of the process and welcome the 2000 delegates to Sibu.

Unfortunately, the government announced that the MCO will be implemented due to COVID-19 on the 18th March.

All the hard work went down the drain and the Committee was greatly disappointed.

None-the-less, we prepared ourselves for another comeback in bidding for the 59th Convention 2021 in Sibu and to our great excitement, we finally got the hosting right again.

We then went on to change and amend numerous organization process and documents to better prepare. We were honoured as it's been 25 years since Sibu hosted such an important Lions event. Covid-19 struck again and this time it's even worse than last year. There is a foreboding in all of us that the Convention is unlikely to happen in Sibu.

Four years of preparation works, organization; from bidding to promotion and to realize the goals, looking after each minute detail, drafting checklists and follow up lists for each team and task force and finally closing the registration at 2052 delegates.

I am disappointed but again, the safety and well-being of everyone are our main priority. As no one can predict that the Covid-19 will be this bad, we have agreed to cancel this Convention that will have more than 2000 people attending. I wish to extend my sincere gratitude to each and every one of my Committee members. I have seen how hard they worked, how much they contributed and although the Convention is cancelled, the unity and team spirit displayed throughout the past four years have been nothing short of a grand legacy for the other lions. Although the 59th MD308 Lions Convention can only be held online via Virtual, I would like to express my sincere thanks to the Council of Governors for appointing me as the COCC of the 59th Convention. Once again, sincere gratitude to all the Council of Governors for FY2019/2020 and FY2020/2021 for your generous support and cooperation.







The club hopes the small donation will help them face these trying times and the club also prayed for their speedy recovery. Junaida is awaiting


operation in the coming week while her husband's legs are in cast.



IMPROVING YOUR MEMBER RETENTION

Keeping current members is a sign of a club's stability and overall wellbeing. Many clubs don't recognize their retention problems if the number of members remains somewhat steady. However, clubs that consistently lose members and compensate by recruiting new members are not managing their growth or retention well.

We often talk about the problems with membership and retention, yet more times than not, talking is all we do. The key to a solution in the area membership and retention is often talked about, but it is rarely done.

Strategies for keeping member: -

Review your club's historical and existing member retention percentage. Determine when and why members leave your club. Knowing at what point /reasons that members are most likely to leave can help you recognize the club's retention strengths and weaknesses and focus your efforts accordingly.

People join a Lions club for many reasons, but chief among them is to volunteer their time and help those in need. If these members are not given the experience they are looking for, and don't feel that their contributions are needed or valued, they will look elsewhere for an outlet to volunteer.

Strategies for keeping member: -

Is your club's meeting time, format, and location convenient for members with families or young professionals still building their careers?

Educate members. Provide continuity of quality leadership training.

Consider a member brunch, picnic, pool party, or other fun gathering.

Consider the affordability of dues and events. Consider easing the financial obligations of members who may be under financial strain because of retirement or other factors.

"Buddy system" in which teams of four members stay in touch and support one another.

Organize interesting club meeting programs that will make members want to come back for more. Making club meetings fun, energetic, and humorous.

Actively involve all members in projects and activities according to their interests, skills, and availability. Engage members in meaningful project, long term signature project, hands-on project.

Assigning newer members to committees or otherwise involving them in the club.

Assign good mentors to newer members.


Organize new activities.

Get members' feedback on their club experience and ask for their ideas on what could be improved. They may have ideas for revitalizing the club's meetings, fellowship activities or service projects.

Serving the community is about caring and sharing; it is about compassion and kindness; it is about generosity; it is about sacrifice and love; it is about giving.

Many service organizations struggle and start to lose their volunteers when community services are not meaningful, bad and ineffectual leaders, and when there are full of internal politics.





People need to be comfortable to work well together. Foster friendship.
